

Ques. What is D. Pharma Exit Exam?

Ans. D. Pharma Exit Examination was implemented for this purpose to test the skills and knowledge of the students who want to get Pharmacist Registration Certificate by passing the D. Pharma exam. So that it can be known whether the student who has passed the D. Pharma University examination is eligible to get registration or not and if he/she is eligible to get registration then he/she is eligible to practice pharmacy as a registered pharmacist in private or government hospital or clinic.

Ques. Why D. Pharma Exit Exam was proposed?

Ans. To test the knowledge, skills, discipline, judgment of the students who have passed the D. Pharma University Examination. After that PCI will know whether the student is eligible to get registration or not. And to take action against those colleges which are running on non-legal basis.

Ques. Who can give D. Pharma Exit Exam?

Ans. D. Pharma University Passed out students (2022-2023). Students who were completed D. Pharma in 2023.

Ques. What subjects included for D. Pharma Exit Exam?

Ans. Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutical chemistry, Pharmacology, Biochemistry, Hospital & Clinical Pharmacy, Community Pharmacy & Management, Human Anatomy & Physiology, Social Pharmacy, Pharmacotherapeutics




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
